- a. Crisis Workgroup Progress: Ms. McAtee explained the goal behind community crisis response is to reduce fear in needing a responder to arrive on scene and go through the emergency room process. She went on to describe the process in which the Community Responder will respond effectively to de-escalate the process and encourage the issues to be resolved through alternative means. Mr. Gale requested feedback on the fit of chaplains within the system. Ms. Karen explained that the Crisis response is an added tool that is not to be used for a replacement. They have not co-responded at this time, but that's definitely a possibility for the future. Discussion continued regarding the lack of shared data regarding the responses and how a possible situation could play out. Ms. McAtee went on regarding the possible collaborations possible throughout the state. Gallatin County organizations involved are the first of our kind to respond in this effort, which is drawing attention throughout the state.
