Bylaw Amendments

Current:

Voting Members (civilians):

Shall serve up to 6 years through three (3) two-year terms.

After the first two (2) year term, voting members may be invited to renew additional terms until they reach a maximum of six years.

Proposed:

Voting Members (Civilians):

Shall serve four (4) year terms.

Members may serve up to two (2) consecutive terms.

Upon completion of two consecutive terms, members may be subject to replacement through the application and appointment process.

If no qualified applicants are identified, the member may:

(a) be reappointed to an additional term; or

(b) transition to Member-at-Large status.

Nothing in this section shall be interpreted to require reappointment or continued service; the Council or appointing authority retains discretion to appoint a new member or leave the position vacant.

Current:

Section 1. Officers. A Chair and Vice Chair will be elected by a majority of the members to serve a two (2) year term, and may be re-elected to a second term. Election of these two (2) positions will take place every even numbered year at the regular August Meeting.

Proposed:

Section 1. Officers. The Council shall elect a Chair and a Vice Chair by majority vote of the voting members. Each officer shall be elected separately. Officers shall serve a two (2) year term beginning upon their election and may be re-elected for additional terms without limitation. Elections shall be held upon the expiration of an officer's term or whenever a vacancy occurs. An officer elected to fill a vacancy shall begin a new two (2) year term upon election.
